## Teachers' Messy Art Night.

Through this hands-on exhibit, children learn geometric principles just by experimenting and playing with bubbles.



There are square bubbles, triangular bubbles - even dodecahedron bubbles.

All of these magical bubble shapes are formed as the children dip three dimensional shapes made from Zometools into a bubble solution.

Zometools are an award winning construction set used by schools nationwide from first grade to the university level. They are used to teach algebra, geometry, DNA structure, trigonometry, art and technology. Professional Mathematicians, Engineers and Computer Scientists use Zometools in their fieldwork to replicate natural structures and geometric designs.

This traveling exhibit was created by TCM's very talented and creative Exhibits Committee. Their expertise includes years of working in education with a specialization in child development, early childhood education and creative art.

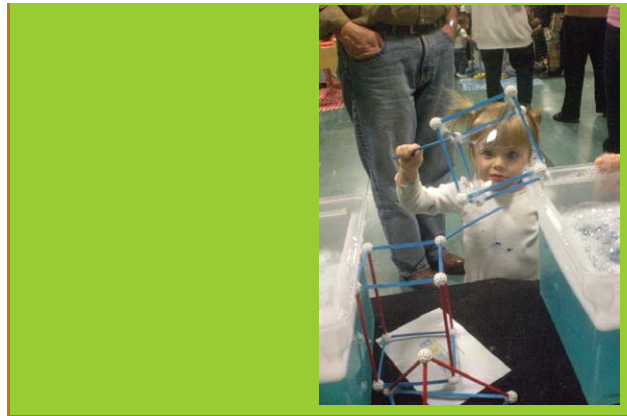
